The Department of Balneology and Physiotherapy (this is its original name) was established by order of the Ministry of Health No. 696 dated December 4, 1987 on the basis of the Sochi Research Institute of Balneology and Physiotherapy at the request of the leadership of Sochi. The leadership of the Kuban State Medical Institute played an important role in organizing the work and forming the department.

The first head of the department was at that time the director of the Sochi Research Institute of Balneology and Physiotherapy, Doctor of Medical Sciences, Professor T.V. Khutiev.

From January 1993 to the present, the department has been located on the basis of the Federal State Institution “Central Clinical Sanatorium named after A.I. F.E. Dzerzhinsky FSB of Russia” in Sochi.

The head of the department is Anatoly Timofeevich Bykov, Corresponding Member of the Russian Academy of Medical Sciences, Doctor of Medical Sciences, Professor, Honored Doctor of the Russian Federation, laureate of the Russian Government Prize in the field of science and technology. Professor A.T. Bykov is the author of over 267 scientific papers, dozens of books and monographs on modern technologies of restorative medicine. Under his leadership, 18 candidate and 11 doctoral dissertations were defended.

The department has a well-equipped diagnostic and treatment base that meets modern requirements, which allows for practical training at a high level. In the last five years alone, 6 monographs and 9 manuals for physicians have been published. Published more than 50 articles in journals, scientific collections, books. 2 doctoral and 10 master's theses were defended (supervisors - A.T. Bykov and K.V. Gordon).
